Peggy George: have any of you figured out how to get different things highlighted in the text box for the description of the survey? Like bold, larger or different font, colored text, etc.? I've been able to bold words by using html code but haven't tried many others.

Peggy George: that's a great tip about editing the confirmation! and you can use it to direct people to a web page or wiki that may have additional resources for them.

Moderator (Katie Christo 1): Oh great idea with the setting notifications!

Moderator (Katie Christo 1): @Peggy love the idea of having a link to a wiki or web page with more info!

Peggy George: setting notifications is so important!! We use a google form for webinar participants to complete to request a PD certificate. If they don't all submit it immediately following the webinar I know I will receive notification no matter when it comes in.
